

Landscape Painting Class

Villa Maria location

Exit at Grant / Foothill from 280. Go west on Foothill (the direction of San Antonio Park). If you are coming from South 280, turn left and pass under the bridge. If you are coming from North 280, turn right. Continue on Foothill which changes into Stevens Creek Canyon Rd., after it crosses Stevens Creek Blvd. (at the crossroad with an "Arco cheap gaz" station on your left - Bateh Bros. store on your right). Continue past the houses and on in the direction of Stevens Creek Reservoir.

The first sign on your left that says "Stevens Creek County Park " is the entrance of our location. You can see a parking lot down below from the road. Take the entrance on the left to enter the park, as it goes down and turns to the right, pass the parking lot on your left. The little road divides itself and goes to the Park Ranger Station on the right. Continue on your left and climb a little hill with some beautiful stands of eucalyptus. A sign says: "Villa Maria" to the left. At the top of the hill, use the parking lot on your right, we meet in the shade.

Description: Beautiful Oak Grove, lots of shade, patterns of light and dark, vistas through the trees, pic-nic tables. On the other side of the parking lot, a wild area, large vistas, golden hills, walnut orchard and a family of deers... This is a very friendly location, very rich in painting inspiration.
